## CURRENT DOHA PROJECTS:



We are helping our Local Partner to provide clothing and shoes to 100 children living in the Kaya Refugee Camp in South Sudan.

We are helping our Local Partner to provide Food Aid to 4 areas of concern in India (West Bengal, Assam, Manipur & Naga Land) which is facing food insecurity due to the global pandemic.

We are helping our Local Partner to provide food and non-food aid relief to communities in South Sudan Upper Nile affected by the flooding.

We are also partnering with African Action International (AAI) in three new projects:

#### \*AAI Water and Solar Project Uganda.

This Project will provide the School and community with constant clean water (needed for drinking, cooking and sanitation) and solar power to provide lighting for safety and for the Medical Clinic.

#### \*AAI Kitchen Garden and Poultry Project in Kenya.

This Project will help families improve their food security by enabling them to grow their own food (vegetables, fruit, herbs/spices and poultry).

#### \*AAI Fencing Project in Kenya.

This Project will provide Vocational Training for the same community who are creating Kitchen Gardens. It soon became apparent that fencing was required to protect the gardens. This Project will train the community how to build and maintain fencing.
